Backing Up Your Customizations to iTunes

You must do a manual backup to iTunes (not iCloud) if you want to save your notes, bookmarks, and highlights to restore them onto a different device.

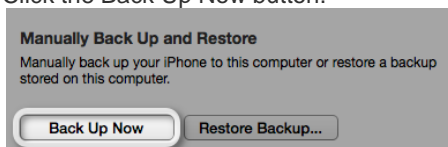
Important Note: Disable autosync in iTunes BEFORE connecting your iPad to do a manual Backup and keep autosync off when you connect your new iPad and Restore to the manual Backup. [Edit ->Preferences ->Devices -> check box that prevents devices from autosyncing.]

How to back up

- Connect your iOS device to your computer with the latest version of iTunes installed.
- Click "iPad" to see the Summary Tab. [on older versions of iTunes, you must Right-click (or Control-click) the iOS device in iTunes under Devices and choose Back Up]
- Click the Back Up Now button.

REMEMBER: Disable autosync in iTunes before completing a Backup and Restore. You can turn it back on after the Restore is complete.

Results are identified within a plate with a yellow highlight and the search icon.

3. browse by region, browse by system

- Tap the info icon next to muscle labels to see attachments, innervations, actions, and blood supply.
- Quiz yourself on terminology with label quizzes.

Quizzes are based on whether you have highlighted or hidden labels. If you want to be quizzed on more than the customizations, adjust the quiz settings.

- Make the Netter Atlas your own personal anatomy study guide and use the “My Netter” features to customize labels on each plate, bookmark plates, and add notes for different study sessions: Lab, an upcoming test, a PBL case, etc.
